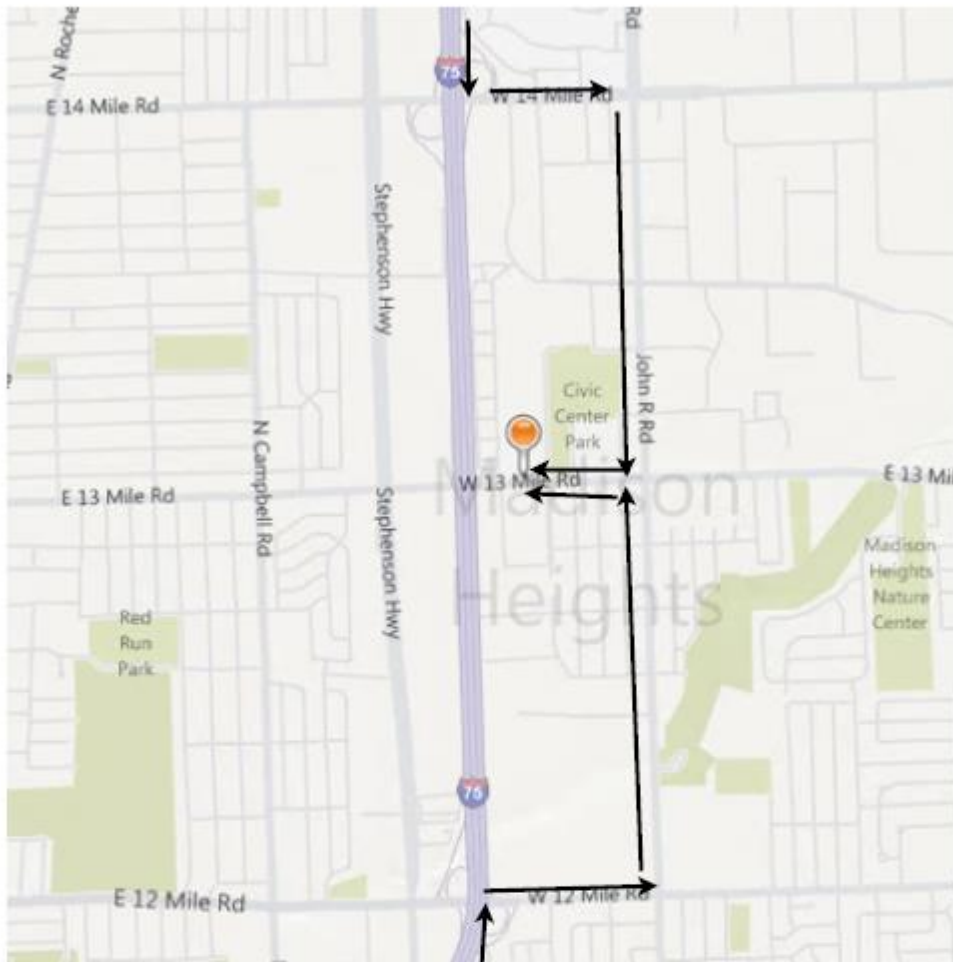

Traffic Pattern at Lamphere Invitational - October 2, 2021

BUSES will enter at the west driveway (no traffic light) and proceed to the north end of the building. After dropping off, proceed north to bus yard for parking. Students will board buses here following the show.

EQUIPMENT TRUCKS will enter at the east driveway (signal controlled), and proceed north to the maintenance yard for parking and unloading. Props stay near equipment vehicles and join their band as they take the field. Instruments proceed south to warm-up areas.

SPECTATORS will also enter at the east driveway (signal controlled), and proceed to either the large lot by the tennis courts, or the small lots west of the building. Handicap parking is accessible from the west side of the large spectator lot.

BAND MEMBERS may enter the school building to use restrooms near bus drop-off, and then will proceed north to the equipment trucks and bus parking at the bus yard. Pit equipment and band members will move along the red indicated path to warm-up areas, back north to the stadium for performance, and then immediately back to the truck parking area.
