## Milford Homecoming - Friday, October 15

## **School Day:**

Pep Assembly – 12:58 pm after 6th hour

We will play pep songs as students come into the assembly, and then we will play the Fight Song at the very start. We are staying down there with instruments and will play throughout the assembly.

## Parade:
