



#### SCHOOL ACCESS, "BUS DROP-OFF", PARKING

It is advised that you use the Flemings Lake Rd. access. Use the driveway directly in front of the school to unload students. There will be attendants to assist you with parking, check-in, and further instructions. We are asking all participants to use only the main entrance upon arrival. Event parking for spectators, staff, etc. will be the student lot, the lot in front of the school and the lot closest to the stadium. Handicapped and special needs parking access much closer to the stadium will be available for those who need this in the lot right next to the stadium.

#### **EQUIPMENT TRAILERS, ETC**

Use the first driveway on the west end of the campus. Personnel will be stationed at the lot entrance to direct your equipment vehicles to a staging area adjacent to and behind the school allowing convenient access to the stadium.

#### CHECK-IN, GUIDES, AND COAT ROOMS

Directors are requested to have students remain on their buses until a representative has checked in and a guide has been assigned. Restrooms are available inside the main entrance to the high school but anyone coming inside our buildings must be masked, including for critique. Per MCBA, no coatrooms will be used this fall.

#### **WARM-UP AREAS**

All warm-up areas will be <u>outside - no indoor warm-up areas</u>. We have designated three separate warm up areas, "A", "B", and "C" that <u>will be timed locations</u>. Warm up for percussion and colorguard are designated on the map and are in a different location than wind sections. Wind sections will use our new turf practice field. Percussion need to be in a different location to keep the sound from carrying to the performance field.
